Read Around the Planet (RAP) is a celebration of reading. CILC provides the registration tool, matches classrooms with partners and provides support documents. Participating classrooms are responsible for their video connection and developing their own reading activities. CILC can provide video connections on a first-come basis. Participation is free!

The activity is open to all PreK-12 students (ages 4-18) in public and private schools who have access to two-way interactive video capability. Participate in English, Spanish or English as a Second Language.

Your class will be matched with a class from a different location, and each class will exchange reading activities. Spanish and ESL classes will be matched in the same category, but may not be the same grade level.
