## Dear Educator:

We are scheduled for an **American Indians: Cultures and Contributions (AICC)** program with your student(s).

You will need to do some preparation prior to the program if you choose to participate in the OPTIONAL art activity.

- 1. The materials needed for this activity are the following (per student):
  - 1 toilet paper roll
  - 1 piece of white copy paper (any paper will work)
  - 1 glue stick OR roll of tape (scotch tape or masking tape... any kind of tape will work!)
  - 1 pencil to trace templates
  - 1 pair of scissors to cut out templates (head and body of horse)
  - Optional- markers, crayons to decorate horse
- 2. The directions and other documents needed for the program are attached below. *Each student needs these materials in order to fully participate in the craft.*
- 3. Please bring all pre-cut pieces and other materials to the program. <u>Each student will need to cut out their horse templates (head and body) before the start of the program.</u>
- 4. Pass out all materials PRIOR to program start time.
- 5. We will lead all students through horse building steps and learning activities. <u>The program does not allow time for students to cut out materials.</u>
