Read through these sentences, paying special attention to the bolded words. These vocabulary words will be helpful while you're participating in the Gray Wolf 101 WolfLink Presentation!

Wolves live in a **pack**, or a group of wolves, usually a mom, dad, and their offspring.

When wolves have babies they are not called wolf babies; they are called **wolf pups**.

Wolf pups are born in **den sites**, where they will live with their siblings and mom for their first few weeks of life.

These den sites will be in a wolf's **territory** or home, which they protect from other wolf packs.

Wolves have to eat meat, making them **carnivores**.

Wolves can't go to the grocery store for food; they must hunt. Animals that hunt other animals for food are called **predators**.

The pack lives and hunts together. They can "talk" to or **communicate** with each other in different ways. Using different sounds or **vocalizations**, **body language**, and **scents** to communicate with other wolves.

Wolves are carnivores and predators, and they live in packs.
